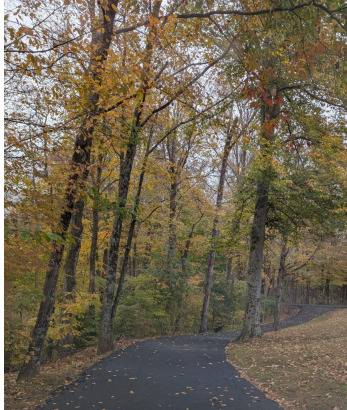


Feeling Grateful

Being grateful is a deep, internal feeling of appreciation of something or someone.

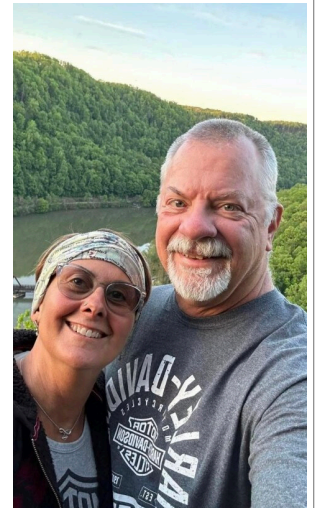
I had asked what you all might be grateful for on our DC HOG Facebook page, and here are a few responses.
